Service Delivery

July 1, 2006 – June 30, 2007

Armed Forces Emergency Services (AFES)

- Provided 1,250 services (including emergency assistance, counseling, and communications services)
- Briefed 1,465 Military members through “outreach”
- Completed 229 Cases

Blood Services

- Collected 25,231 Units
- Held over 340 community blood drives
- Held 319 additional drives at Nussbaum Blood Center
- 13,272 Donors
- 2,166 First Time Donors

Disaster Services

- Responded to 89 Local Disaster Operations, including house fires or floods
- Provided nearly \$99,000 in emergency assistance to 110 families
- 133 Disaster Services Human Resources Members (DSHR)
- Trained 720 citizens in disaster preparedness and response

International Emergency Services

- Delivered 16 international Red Cross messages
- Successfully completed four international tracings
- Seven families have been linked or assisted

Volunteer Services

- Volunteer to staff ratio: 136:1
- 3,544 volunteers

Health & Safety Services

- Certified 12,434 individuals in First Aid, CPR and AED courses
- Trained 4,825 individuals in Aquatics and Water Safety
- Certified 353 participants in Babysitter’s training
- Services provided through the chapter by 421 Red Cross trained instructors
- Provided workplace training to 281 local businesses
